High School Curriculum

The instructional program is designed to train students for college. Minimum of 22.5 credits are required for graduation with a three-course sequence each of math and science but preferably a four-course sequence in each to prepare for college admissions. The breakdown is as follows:

Bible	4 credits (one credit for each year student attends Upton Lake HS)
English	4 credits
Social Studies	4 credits
Mathematics	3 credits (Students usually graduate with a sequence of 3 but may take 4)
Science	3 credits (Students usually graduate with a sequence of 3 but may take 4)
Foreign Lang.	1 credit
Fine Arts	1 credit (Includes music)
Physical Ed.	2 credits (half credit each year 9-12)
Health	¹ / ₂ credit

Community Service hours are averaged in with the Bible grade. 14 hours required in grades 7, 8, 9. 18 hours required in grades 10, 11, 12.
