

## 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE: COLLEGE PLANNING TIMELINE

Recommended college prep activities

FALL: SELECT COLLEGES, EXAMS, APPLICATIONS, FAFSA
☐ Narrow down your college list to those you would like to attend.
☐ Continue to visit colleges if your list is not complete.
☐ Create a master list or calendar that includes:
<ul> <li>Tests you need to take and dates</li> </ul>
College application due dates
Required financial aid forms and deadlines
• Miscellaneous materials you will need (recommendation letters, etc.)
Apply for a fee waiver if you can't afford application fees (income based).
<ul> <li>□ Continue your scholarship search.</li> <li>□ Take the SAT or ACT one more time if needed.</li> </ul>
Make sure to have SAT or ACT scores sent to colleges to which you are applying.
<ul> <li>□ Complete the FAFSA (some colleges also require the CSS Profile).</li> <li>□ Request teacher recommendation letters.</li> </ul>
☐ Write first draft of essay(s), have reviewed and prepare revised essay(s).
☐ Complete at least one college application by Thanksgiving. Make plans to finish all of them.
